

1. The 2023-2024 District Polio Challenge

We are running a competition that will reward clubs for their per capita polio giving for the 23-24 Rotary year. We are fundraising a pool of funds from sponsors. 80% of that funding will go to a prize pool to be split by clubs with the highest per capita giving for the year. The remaining 20% will support our District Ride to End Polio on June 8th, 2024.

2. What's in it for your Club?

To stimulate giving to Polio Plus, we will reserve a minimum of \$10,000 of funding raised from corporate donors to award to clubs with highest per capita giving. Using \$10,000 as the example we would award:

1 st	\$4,000
2 nd	\$3,000
3 rd	\$2,000
4 th	\$1,000

The awards must be used for a club service project in your community. Basing the awards on per capita giving levels the playing field between large and small clubs.

3. Duration of the Campaign

We will count all Polio giving by every club from July 1st, 2023 to June 30th, 2024. As an added bonus, any giving to contributed to anyone that is part of District 5650 Polio Ride team on Raise for Rotary will **be counted double**. The Raise for Rotary campaign will also run from July 1st, 2023 to June 30th, 2024.

Benefit to your club

First, this will help you meet Polio giving goals. Second, you can potentially gain a significant return on investment...particularly for small clubs

Date: June 8th, 2024

Who can Ride: Open to Everyone, not just Rotarians...and it's open to families and children

Distances: 10, 25, 42, and 62 miles

Where: Will start at the Twin Creeks Cinema Parking lot. The 10, 25, and 42 mile rides will be all on trails. The 62 mile ride will spend some time on streets (about 3 miles).

Cost: \$40 per rider. Registration includes a t-shirt and donation to Polio Plus. Registrations will open March 22nd.

Fundraising: All funds outside the registration raised for the ride will count double towards your Polio competition goal, including those from non-Rotarians associated with your club.

What other activities will happen along with the ride: We'll have food trucks, bike clinics and a health fair at the start/finish area for the riders.
